We only promise a minimum, you likely will be scheduled for more hours (if needed and hours are available). We expect you to follow your posted schedule. Food Service employees are limited to NO more than 40 hours per week.

You must be available to work nights, holidays and weekends! The schedule might change weekly and you must be prepared to work accordingly. You are expected to show up for work on time and not miss shifts.

Shifts may vary from 6 to 12 hours. Some positions require assisting guests in and out of rides/attractions which may include lifting children. Employees must be available to work day and night shifts in varying weather (rain, wind, cold temperatures, direct sunlight or high heat and humidity). The noise level in the work environment is usually loud. All employees will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending. These activities also require considerable use of the arms, back and legs. Employees may be required to lift, push, pull, or carry objects up to 50 lbs on a repeated basis.
