ERASMUS MUNDUS WHAT IS PHOENIX?

PHOENIX is funded with the support of the Erasmus Mundus-Action 2 Programme of the European Commission. Phoenix project intends to develop a structured mobility based cooperation between 3 Palestinian, 2 Lebanese, 1 Syrian and 2 Jordanian Higher Education Institutions on the one side and 9 European Higher Education Institutions from the second side.

This cooperation network aims at supporting students from all levels (Undergraduate, Master, PhD and Posdoctoral), academic staff, researchers and administrative staff to gain experiences, expertise and skills through interaction in an international environment.



WHO ARE THE BENEFICIARIES?

PHOENIX scholarships are aimed at students, researchers and staff who are European nationals or nationals of Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine or Syria, who fall within the following target groups:

- Target Group 1: Students, researchers and staff registered (or working) in one of the higher education institutions member of the partnership.
- Target Group 2: Nationals of the third countries concerned and national of European countries who:
- Are registered/work in a Higher Education Institution not included in the partnership.
- Have obtained a university degree or equivalent by a Higher Education Institution of any European country or third country concerned (Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine or Syria) (students only).
- Target Group 3: Nationals of Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine or Syria who are in particularly vulnerable situations, for social and political reasons (check the project web site for more information).

COMPOSITION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

PHOENIX offers 150 scholarships that cover travel expenses, participation costs (if applicable), health insurance and a monthly allowance.)

The call for applications will be opened for a limited period of time. The on-line application form and all the relevant information will be available in the project web site.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS THAT APPLY TO ALL CANDIDATES?

- Must have sufficient knowledge of the language of the courses or of one of the languages currently spoken in the hosting countries;
- Must have not benefited in the past from an Erasmus Mundus Action 2-Strand 1 for the same type of mobility.

For Students from Jordan, Syria, Palestine and Lebanon:

- Must be a national of one of the third-countries covered by the project.
- Must have not resided nor have carried out their main activity (studies, work, etc) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in any of the eligible European countries at the time of submitting their application (not applicable to TGIII candidates).

For European Students:

- Must be a national of one of the eligible European countries
- Undergraduate students must have successfully completed at least one year of studies at first higher education level.



Please, check the project web site to find out the specific eligibility requirements for staff and for each Target Group.

Mobility flows for students and staff between the European or between third-country institutions involved in the partnership are not eligible.
